Our global marketing activities are undertaken by Inter-Continental Oils & Fats (ICOF) - a member of Musim Mas Group.




History of Musim Mas

Musim Mas started out with humble beginnings in 1932 in Medan, Indonesia, as Nam Cheong Soap Factory.


The company has grown from strength to strength since its first foray into palm oil refining in 1970, as well as plantation and mill management in 1988 and 1991 respectively.


